Barnes' mission to promote fine-arts appreciation and education, commissioned the development of 12-ft.-tall sections of murals, which measure up to 130 ft. long, that promote the foundation's future home on Philadelphia's Benjamin Franklin Parkway. Cloud Gehshan Assoc, designed the program with Adobe's Photoshop and Illustrator programs. Urban Sign & Crane produced inkjet-printed panels of 3M's Controltac film wrapped over Nudo Products' AlumaCorr™ panels that were attached with a series of modular, arched sections connected to form the ribbon.
